## Prairie Mountain Fiddlers Code of Conduct Adopted April 11, 2016

The Prairie Mountain Fiddlers was formed in 1987 with the objectives to provide for the recreation of members and afford the opportunity for friendly and social activities. To encourage and promote amateur musicians in Old Time Fiddle music.

The following Code of Conduct applies to all PMF members and is designed to ensure a safe and positive environment where members can contribute musically to the PMF and learn new tunes while promoting and upholding the reputation of PMF.

## **Code of Conduct:**

- Show respect for all members. This includes respect during jamming sessions and performances. Examples of respectful behavior is to be on time, accepting a member's music and tempo choices during jam sessions without criticism and deferring to the music leader during structured sessions.
- 2. Welcome and encourage new members to PMF.
- 3. Conduct yourselves with professional conduct while representing PMF at all PMF functions. Refrain from language and behavior that could be interpreted as discriminatory, disrespectful and/or offensive to others.
- 4. Discrimination and harassment on the basis of race, colour, creed religion, sex, marital status, sexual orientation, disability, age, or national origin will not be tolerated.
- 5. Offensive behavior resulting from the use of alcohol and drugs will not be tolerated.
